SKYTEAM AT MOSCOW SHEREMETYEVO TERMINAL D

SkyTeam continues to expand its global network to provide a smooth travel experience for its passengers, with its forthcoming collocation at Sheremetyevo International Airport Terminal D.

A major SkyTeam hub, the multi-year project at Moscow Sheremetyevo has resulted in a state-of-the-art terminal that utilizes the most advanced technology and airport processes.

In addition to greater convenience and higher quality service for passengers, the collocation at Sheremetyevo Terminal D will maximize airport facility utilization and help participating member carriers share costs.

TIMELINE

SkyTeam's presence at Moscow Sheremetyevo will develop throughout 2009 and 2010:

- **November 2009** – Sheremetyevo Terminal D opens to passengers as the first flights operate from the terminal
- **December 2009** – SkyTeam member airline Aeroflot international flights transfer from Terminal B (formerly Terminal 1) to Terminal D
- **February 2010** – Aeroflot relocates its international flights to Terminal D from Terminals C and F
- **August 2010** – Participating SkyTeam member airlines (Alitalia, China Southern, Czech Airlines, Delta Air Lines, Korean Air) relocate to Terminal D; Aeroflot operates a total of 94 international flights from Terminal D

SEAMLESS CONNECTIONS

Sheremetyevo Terminal D was designed to accommodate a large quantity of daily passengers efficiently and effectively. It is expected to serve 12 million passengers annually.

A key differentiator of Terminal D is the international and domestic flight combinations within one terminal, providing passengers seamless transfers. In fact, international flight transfers will take an average of 40 minutes – the lowest minimum connection time in Russia – while international to domestic flight transfers will take an average of 60 minutes.
